Abstracts are invited for free papers and poster presentations or video presentation, for the open discussion forum during Sammelan. Please send abstract of less than 200 words, for what you are going to speak or display as poster or video. The time allotted is 5 minutes for podium presentation and videos. Please present your best work, and in a crisp manner.

Please mention the title, authors' names, presenting authors name, address, place where study was done, and period. Also mention if it is a podium presentation, poster or video. Certificates for all the presentations will be as if for podium presentation. Scientific Committee may shift a presentation from podium to poster if it deems fit.

Optional tour on 6th January 2014 will be taken to the Pench Tiger Reserve, Maharashtra. Pench Tiger Reserve is one of the most beautiful landscapes of Central India. This 'The gateway of the tigerland' is located 80 km from Nagpur. Expected expenses are around 1000/- to and fro Pench Tiger Reserve and include one safari. We will be returning on the same day by evening 6.00 pm.

About Wild-CER:

Society for Wildlife Conservation, Education and Research (Wild-CER) is a conservation organization based at Nagpur. Being involved in the rescue and rehabilitation of the wild animals, their treatment, care and management in captivity for more than one and half decade, we are trying to resolve man- animal conflict issues. We are also involved in the research related diseases of wild animals, their management in captive and free ranging wild animals and birds. Several research articles has been published in national and international journals. Scientists of Wild-CER have also reported Babesiosis in Nilgai for the first time in central India. At present we are involved in 'Vulture Conservation at Pench Tiger Reserve, Maharashtra' and 'Man-animal conflict at Melghat Tiger Reserve' project in collaboration with the state forest department. With the tremendous efforts of volunteers, rescuers and veterinarians of Wild-CER, we have rescued hundred of wild animals/birds so far. In 2013 we have rescued and treated more than 300 birds.
